

Waiting Around:

Ten Things to Do Before Your Building Goes (OS1)

EDITOR'S NOTE

At the Simon Institute Executive meeting it was decided to provide a list of educational opportunities that facilities could engage in while waiting for the (OS1) implementation to come to their building. Below is a list of activities that will assist in the (OS1) transition and not interfere in any way with cleaning workers still engaged in the old program. (OS1) trainers should be ready to assist buildings that want to adopt any of the 10 (OS1) program components in advance of the official (OS1) start in their location.

#1 Introduce the **(OS1) Educational Odyssey Map** and discuss future career paths including the **(OS1) Verification of Training** program in your non (OS1) buildings.

#2 Install the **“(OS1) Beyond Compliance”** program in your non (OS1) building and begin removing old chemicals, while working of the **Protect Yourself Verification of Training** programs.

#3 Install the **“(OS1) Protect Yourself”** program in your non (OS1) building and build **(OS1) Bloodborne Pathogen Clean-up Kits** while working of the **Protect Yourself Verification of Training** programs.

#4 Clean up closets and paint them to get ready for the **Visually Instructive (OS1) Logistics** program in your non (OS1) buildings.

#5 Install the **“(OS1) Watch Your Back”** program in your building by hanging the (OS1) Kinesiology Poster in the future check-in location and spend three minutes warming-up at the beginning of each shift.

#6 Install the **“(OS1) Tom Shirley Program”** program in your non (OS1) buildings. Show videos and begin with one product at a time while working on the Tom Shirley Verification of Training program.

#7 Set up the **“(OS1) Visually Instructive Workplace Signage”** in your non (OS1) buildings.

#8 Begin to set up the **“(OS1) Max/Min”** in your non (OS1) buildings.

#9 Introduce the **“Science of Cleaning”** in your non (OS1) buildings by having the trainers present the Bakers Dozen lesson for March. Provide each employee with a copy of Dr. Berry's presentation to the (OS1) Symposium in 2006.

#10 Have a **Janus Coin** Recognition Meeting for those non (OS1) buildings who have all four levels of **(OS1) Verification of Training**.
